


David Cooley is back in town to wow us with jazzy tunes that will get our toes tapping and hands clapping! This is our Valentine's social where we crown this years royalty.

Royalty will be announced at social hour on February 13th, and displayed on the Activities board by the mailboxes.



Enjoy a scenic drive to Junction City for a delicious lunch at the Viking Inn.






